RULES AND REGULATIONS:

ENTRIES: There will be a post entry fee of \$5 per class if entered after the marked entry closing date! Class fees are \$15. Jumper Classes with prize money class fees are \$30 and require a minimum entry of 6 horses to be eligible for prize money. Hunter Derby class fee is \$50.00 with a minimum entry of 6 horses to be eligible for prize money. No numbers will be issued without an open check or signed rider liability release form (Liability Release form can be found on our website - ValhallaEquestrianLLC.com/events.) Current coggins must be presented to the horse show office for all horses on the grounds. **Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.**

FEES & REFUNDS: \$5.00 office fee, \$5.00 EMT fee and \$5.00 scholarship fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. An EMT will be on the grounds during posted schooling and show times. **Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged.** Non-members will be charged a NTHJC non-member fee of \$20 per show. NTHJC memberships can be paid at the show or online at www.nthjc.com. Returned checks are subject to a \$25 fee. A \$15 service fee may be applied to open checks not closed by the conclusion of the show.

STABLING: Stalls- \$75.00 – Shavings \$10.00 per bag (minimum of 3 bags) – Ground/haul-in fees - \$35.00 for all non showing horses that are just schooling on the grounds or non stabled horses. Stall reservations must be made in advance, late stall fees \$100.00. Stalls will be available noon Friday thru Sunday. No outside shavings allowed.

SCHOOLING: There will be open schooling Friday from 4:00 pm until 7:00 pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from 6:30 am until times stated on schedule. There will be 15 minutes restricted to Limit riders both mornings. No jumper or Derby schooling.

ARENAS & FOOTING: Indoor Arena-150'X250' Outdoor ring -150'X250', sand footing.

DOGS: All dogs on the property must be held on a leash or confined.

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. Champion ribbon awarded and year end points accrue.

COGGINS: No entry will be accepted without copy of a negative coggins (EIA) within one year, which may be emailed with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival.

ATTIRE: Proper show attire is required. Polos shirts with a collar may be worn in jumper classes. No chaps allowed. Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on the show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

MEDAL CLASSES: are open only to NTHJC members. 1st & 2nd place winners will qualify for the Medal Finals held at the NTHJC Year End Show. Once a rider wins the class twice they may not enter again until the Finals.

LIMIT DIVISIONS: are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 6 blue ribbons over fences. After winning 6 blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in the division for the remainder of the show season.

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles riders may only cross enter into Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Walk Trot Canter 18".

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled. All classes, except warm-ups, with 20 or more entries will be split.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions Sat. and Sun 7:00 AM to conclusion of show.

Class 100 Fee \$50

Open to all horses who have competed in a division at this show. Fence heights are 2'6"-2'9" with option jumps up to 3'. 1st round: Classic Hunter course of at least 10 jumps including an In & Out and minimum of 3 options. 2nd Round: Handy Hunter course of top 12 horses if available. 1 bonus point will be awarded for each option jump completed and in the 2nd round up to ten points may be awarded for handiness. No schooling of the course is allowed. Late entries will ride at the top of the order. 30 minutes prior to the class entries may walk the course with horses in hand only. 3 sets of ribbons through 12th place will be awarded: each round and overall winners.

1ST Place: Award & \$150 2nd-Award & \$100 3rd-\$75 4th-\$60 5th-\$60 6th-\$55

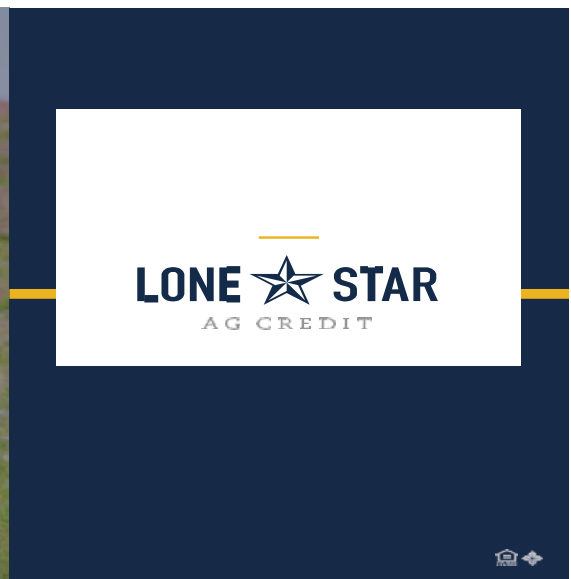
