## **Arabian Horse Association Open Qualifying Program: Dressage/Western Dressage**

Within 30 days of first competition - \$45. After 30 days of first competition - \$75. The annual enrollment fee for the Open Dressage/Western Dressage Qualification Program is \$45 per horse per year and the enrollment and scores must be postmarked/electronic transaction dated to the AHA office within 30 days of the competition date. If the enrollment or scores are sent in after 30 days of the competition date then the fee is \$75 per horse per year. The enrollment year is considered to be from January 1 - December 31.

Scores and qualification points earned from placings can be used from Open Dressage/Western Dressage shows. Shows must be sanctioned by USEF/USDF/EC/WDAA. Results must be sent to the AHA office on the official Open Qualifying Show/Event Report Form. Copies of the applicable pages of the prize list must be included verifying the judges, show secretary & show manager as well as the show name and class list.

The report form must be filled out in full, including the horse's registration number and the rider's current member number. If the report form cannot be signed by the show secretary or manager then the following can be used as verification along with the results form:

- Print out from the USEF or USDF websites of the horse's competition record with the dressage scores listed.
- Copy of the test score sheet with attached verification of the show being sanctioned by USEF/USDF or EC.

In order for results to be recorded the owner and the rider both must hold current AHA competition level memberships. Only scores of 55% or better will be recorded for Intro through 3rd Levels and only scores of 50% or better will be recorded for 4th Level and higher. Scores from schooling shows, Kur and Musical Freestyle do not count and will not be recorded.

**Office Hours:** The show office will be open Friday, April 11<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm . Please notify Charlene if you require move in on Friday. Office will open one hour prior to start of the show each morning

### Rules and Regulations

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 6th places. No paybacks in classes. Judging, class specifications and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF/EC/WDAA Rulebook. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are deemed final and cannot be protested. Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to horse and rider combination with the highest score at Intro, Basic, and First Level and above for Open and ATR.

**Classes:** Classes will be run and adjudicated based on the current USEF/WDAA Rulebook. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason including but not limited to: unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty.

**Stalling Information:** The cost for horse stalls is \$55.00 for overnight stalls, \$35 for day stalls. Stalls are 10X10 with dirt floors. Tack stalls are available. No stalls may be used without payment of appropriate fees. Stalls will be considered reserved only when entry form and appropriate monies are received. Wash racks are available. The facility requires 3 bags of shavings for overnight stalls and 2 bags for day stalls. Stalls are not required for people hauling in for the day.

**Ride Times:** Ride times will be emailed to the exhibitors prior to the show

**Health Requirements:** By Texas law, each horse entering the state of Texas must have a CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE, issued within the last forty-five days by a licensed veterinarian. Any horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a negative Coggins, issued within the last twelve months for all horses. Any horses showing illness will be asked to leave the show grounds.

**Cruelty or Abuse:** Cruelty or abuse of horses is strictly forbidden on the show grounds. Submitting a signed entry constitutes acceptance of this provision.

**Discipline:** Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy or disobedience to horse show officials on the part of the owner, trainer, or rider will disqualify the horse and exhibitor from adjudication. The show management reserves the right to remove such person or persons from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

**Entry Refunds:** Prior to the closing date Friday, March 22, 2019, withdrawals accompanied by a Veterinarian's Certification of Inability to show will receive refund of all fees except office fees. After the closing date only stall fees will be refunded. No refunds after the start of the show

### **Affirmation of the United States Equestrian**

**Federation Helmet/Vest Rule:** GR801.4 Dress

Any exhibitor must wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute. Helmets are strongly encouraged during all schooling and required when showing. Juniors are required to helmets at all times.

**Dogs:** No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds at any time. Violators may be asked to leave the show grounds at the discretion of show management

**ATTENTION COMPETITORS:** Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with the correct association numbers (WDAA) for the horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward regional or national awards.

**Entries:** Entries must be postmarked no later March 22, 2019. If entries received are post marked after the closing date, it will be subject to a \$15.00 additional entry fee per horse. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show management, based on a space available basis and charged a \$15 post entry fee. All entries must be completed on an official entry form for this show and have attached a valid check or money order for the total amount of class entry fees, stall fees, and grounds fees. Any entries received without payment will be rejected. Entries may be emailed but must be complete and monies received via Pay Pal. A horse may only be entered under the legal name of the owner. Each horse/rider must be entered on a separate entry form. In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from US Equestrian Federation, a Recognized competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of an agent, trainer, rider, or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards a Recognized competition or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Recognized competition or its management. NSF and returned checks will be charged a \$50 fee.

**Amateurs:** Every rider or driver having reached his 19th birthday prior to December 1, 2018 must have in his possession a US Equestrian Federation Amateur card to make application for such card at least two hours prior to riding in Amateur designated class. Applications may be secured at the Show Office.

**Businesses/Vendors:** Any person or entity providing services on the show grounds must check in at the show office and will be charged at a minimum the \$25 vendor fee, whether setting up business in the trade fair area or any other area of the show.

**RV and Camper hook-ups are available on a limited basis and will be reserved thru the show office**
